



# International Race - WE 2.2 BELGRADE GP WOMAN TOUR 2021

## SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

### ARTICLE 1. ORGANIZATION

The Organizers of 1st International Woman Elite cycling race „Belgrade GP WOMAN TOUR 2021“ is Cycling Federation of Belgrade, and Sports Association "Zvezdarica" Belgrade, in accordance with UCI Regulations. The race will be held on 12 and 13 June 2021.

### ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF EVENT

It is road stage race and it is open for WOMAN ELITE category.

### ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

Race is open for UCI Womens WorldTeams (max 3), UCI Womens Continental teams, UCI cyclo-cross professional teams, National teams, Regional teams, Clubs teams and Mixed teams. Each team can have minimum 4 and maximum 6 riders.

The organizer will reserve accommodation and meals from Friday (June 11<sup>th</sup>) from dinner until Sunday (June 13<sup>th</sup>) including lunch. Each team pays its own costs of accommodation and meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) per day 30 EUR per person + 1.36 EUR tourist tax.

### ARTICLE 4. RACE HEADQUARTER

Race headquarter is open on Friday, 11 June from 16:30 to 19:00h in Hotel „Jugoslavija“, Belgrade Bulevar Nikole Tesle 3. Race headquarter will be open 1 hour before the start and 1 hour after the finish of 1<sup>st</sup> stage and 2<sup>nd</sup> stage.

### ARTICLE 5. SCHEDULE

The race will take place according to the following schedule:

#### SATURDAY, 12 June - 1<sup>st</sup> STAGE:

07:00 - 08:00 Breakfast - Hotel „Jugoslavija“,

08:30 - Departure to start of the 1<sup>st</sup> stage - Boulevard Nikola Tesla (Palace of Serbia),

09:00 - Closing the race track for another traffic

10:00 - Official start of the 1<sup>st</sup> stage 1/a Individual Time Trial - every rider starts after 1 minute,

11:50 - Finish of the Stage 1/a,

12:30 - 14:00 - Lunch in - Hotel „Jugoslavija“,

15:00 - Signing of the Start list and Team presentation, at Boulevard Nikola Tesla,

15:50 - Official award ceremony Stage 1/a,

16:00 - Official start of the Stage 1/b at Boulevard Nikola Tesla,

19:00 - Finish and award ceremony of the Stage 1/b,

19:30 - 21:00 - Dinner - Hotel „Jugoslavija“.

#### SUNDAY, 13 June - 2<sup>nd</sup> STAGE:

07:00 - 08:00 - Breakfast - Hotel „Jugoslavija“,

08:30 - Departure to start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage – Kalemegdan,

09:00 - Signing of the Start list,

10:00 - Official start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage;

13:00 - Finish of the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage and official award ceremony;

14:00 - Lunch and Shower - Hotel „Jugoslavija“.

The Organizer leaves the possibility, in agreement with President of Commissaire's panel, to change this schedule, if some objective reasons requires it.

## ARTICLE 6. ROUTE

1<sup>st</sup> STAGE - 12/06/2021: Boulevard Nikola Tesla (Palace of Serbia) Belgrade

Stage 1/a - Individual Time trial = 4 km (1 lap) – flat,

Stage 1/b - Circuit race = 92 km (23 laps x 4 km) - flat,

2<sup>nd</sup> STAGE - 13/06/2021: Around Kalemegdan fortrest, Belgrade - Criterium = 70 km (25 laps x 2,8 km).

Every 5<sup>th</sup> lap will be sprint - 4 riders will be get 5, 3, 2, 1 point.

## ARTICLE 7. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT AND REFRESHMENT DURING THE RACE

Accompanied by vehicles is not allowed. The organizer will provide 3 vehicles to accompany the race and a technical assistance zone will be marked at the start / finish line. Parking for all team vehicles will be in the designated area at the start /finish area.

## ARTICLE 8. TIME LIMIT

The time limit will not apply for the stage 1/a. For the stage1/b and stage 2, time limit will be 8%. President of Commissaire's panel, in agreement with the Organizer, may increase the time limit if objective reasons requires it.

## ARTICLE 9. CLASSIFICATIONS

General individual classification will be determined by summing the time from both stages, increased with possible time penalties. Leader in general individual classification wears pink jersey, and the best rider in individual U23 classification wears white jersey. In case that 2 or more riders have the same time, article 2.6.015. from UCI Regulation will be applied.

## ARTICLE 10. PRIZES IN EUR

First 3 riders in each stage will receive medals, and sponsor jeseys for best ELITE and U23 rider.

First 3 riders in general individual classification will receive goblet.

## ARTICLE 11. TIME BONUSES AND PENALTIES

Time bonuses will be applied only to the Individual general classification on stage 1/b and stage 2 for the first 3 riders:

1/b stage - 5“ 3“ 2“

2<sup>nd</sup> stage - 10“, 6“ 4“

UCI penalty scale is only applicable.

## ARTICLE 12. ELIMINATION FROM THE EVENT

The Organizer leaves the possibility not to allow participation or to eliminate from the event each team or participant which presence or behavior damage the reputation of the Organizer, host country or cycling at all.

## ARTICLE 13. PROTOCOL

Following riders must be near official ceremony stage no more then 10 minutes after crossing finish line:

- first 3 riders in stage, jeseys leaders,

- first 3 riders in general individual classification, jeseys leaders.

## ARTICLE 14. SAVING ENVIRONMENT

The organizer is not responsible for the actions among the race participants, the actions of the race participants towards third parties and the actions of third parties towards the race participants.
